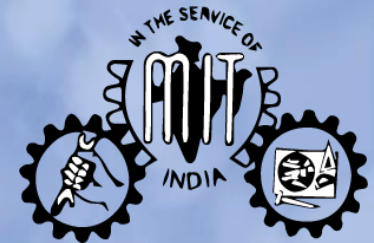

5. International Baccalaureate (IB): International Baccalaureate is a non-profit educational organization that offers prime quality programmes for children aged between 3 and 19.

Opportunities for School Students

Sainik School Society :

- Boys who are between the age of 10-12 years for admission in class VI and 13-15 for admission in class IX on 31 Mar of the year in which admission is sought are eligible to take the examination. For admission to class IX, the boys should be studying in class VIII in a recognized school.
- The aim of Sainik Schools is to prepare boys academically, physically and mentally for entry into National Defence Academy, Khadakwasla, Indian Naval Academy, Ezhimala and other walks of life.

- Admission to the academy is made to only class VIII. Only 25 students from all the states and Union territories are selected in each term.
- RIMC cadets are also provided scholarships by various states and union territories.

National Talent Search Exam

National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) conducts NTSE 2023 exam in 2 stages. Stage 1 of the [NTSE](#) will be held at the state level exam whereas the stage 2 exam will be conducted at the national level. Students studying in class 10 are eligible to appear in the NTSE 2023 exam.

NTSE Eligibility Criteria for Stage I

Only Indian students, who are pursuing their studies from schools in India are eligible to fill [NTSE form](#).

- Students studying in class 10th from recognized schools are eligible to appear in NTSE stage 1.
- Kendriya Vidyalaya, Navodaya Vidyalaya, and Sainik School students can apply for NTSE from the state where their school is located. There will be no domicile restrictions for them.
- Open and Distance Learning (ODL) students are also eligible to appear in the NTSE stage 1. They must not be employed anywhere. They must be appearing in 10th exam for the first time.
- Scholarship of Rs. 1250 per month is awarded for class 11 to 12. Scholarship of Rs. 2000 per month is awarded for Undergraduates and Postgraduates.

Notification month of July Application begins August, Stage I exam November.

Kishore Vaigyanik Protsahan Yojana

The KVPY is an on-going National Program of Fellowship in Basic Sciences, initiated and funded by the Department of Science and Technology, Government of India, to attract exceptionally highly motivated students for pursuing basic science courses and research career in science.

The advertisement for the KVPY Fellowship appears in all the national dailies normally on the Technology Day (May 11) and the Second Sunday of July every year.

Selection of the students is made from those studying in XI standard to 1st year of any undergraduate Program in Basic Sciences namely B.Sc./B.S./B.Stat./B.Math./Int. M.Sc./M.S. in Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and Biology having aptitude for scientific research. Special groups / Committees are set up at IISc to screen the applications and conduct an aptitude test at various centres in the country. Based on the performance in the aptitude test, short-listed students are called for an interview which is the final stage of the selection procedure. For receiving a fellowship, both aptitude test and interview marks are considered.

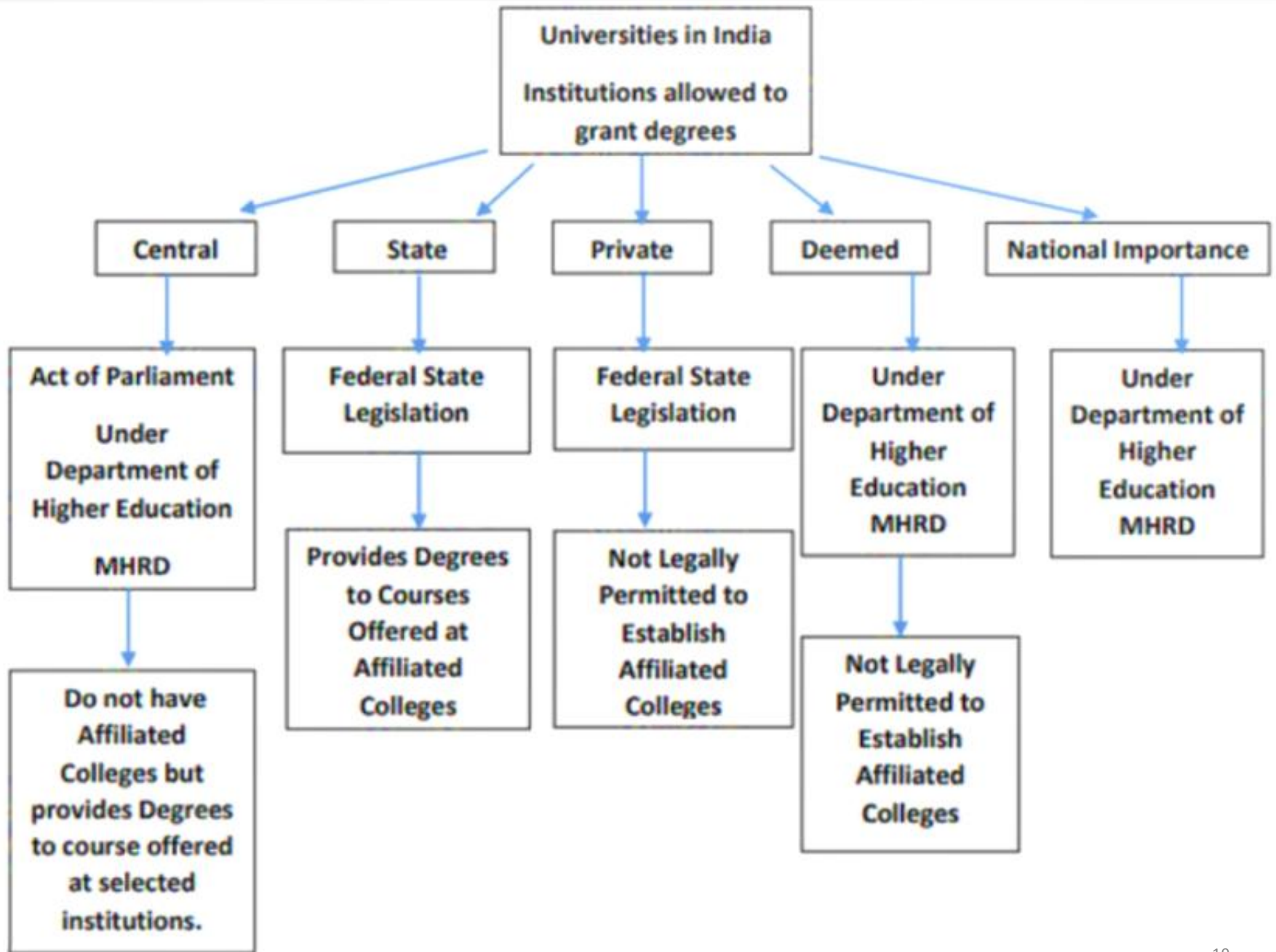

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Common University Entrance Test

The Common University Entrance Test, earlier known as Central Universities Common Entrance Test is an all-India test being organized by National Testing Agency for admission to various Undergraduate, Integrated, Postgraduate, Diploma, Certification courses and Research Programmes in 45 Central Universities of India.

It will be a mandatory test for admission into various UG courses at central universities, BHU, JNU, Delhi University, etc.

Qualification: For UG, candidates must have qualified **12th level exam**

Submission of Application Form could be made by the candidate online through the NTA website: <https://cuet.samarth.ac.in/>

The application process for the Common University Entrance Test (CUET-UG) to be conducted between the 21st and 31st of May will start in the first week of February 2023.

After that CUET results are declared, **all the participating universities will declare their respective course-wise Cut-off for CUET soon.** There will be a separate window with the names of all participating universities/colleges.

Process to become Aircraft Pilot

Qualification to become a pilot in India;

- Minimum 10+2 with Physics and Maths or equivalent (diploma)

Age limit to become a pilot in India;

- You can start early but should be of 18 years to get you CPL.

What medical fitness required to being a pilot?

There are two medicals done CLASS 2 and CLASS 1. Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) has appointed doctors all around India for the above.

The student is also required to clear five DGCA theoretical exams;

1. Air Navigation
2. Meteorology
3. Air Regulations
4. Technical General
5. Technical Specific

The candidate also has to clear a Radio Telephony (RTR) exam conducted by Government of India (Ministry of Telecommunications) six times in a year.

Air Hostess Training Courses in India

- To become an air hostess, the aspirant should have completed 10+2 education in any stream or an undergraduate degree in aviation.
- The minimum age limit for applying for the course is 17 years and the upper age limit is 26 years.
- The candidate should be a minimum of five foot and two inches tall in height.
- The candidate should be unmarried at the time of applying for the course.
- The candidate must have 6/6 vision.
- The candidate must be physically fit with a pleasing personality.
- There will be an initial screening followed by a written test, group discussion and personal interviews. Accepted candidates are put through necessary training in relevant procedures.
