### Dairy Technology: Eligibility Criteria

There are different universities and colleges in India that offer undergraduate and postgraduate courses in dairy technology. Some institutions also offer dairy technology as a vocational subject.

Given below is dairy technology eligibility criteria for undergraduate and postgraduate programmes:

**UG courses**: Candidates should clear Class 12<sup>th</sup> in Science stream with the minimum required percentage (usually 50% - 60%) as stipulated by a university/ college.

**PG courses**: Candidates should possess a graduation degree in dairy technology with the minimum required percentage (usually 50% - 60%) as stipulated by a university/ college.

**Note**: The eligibility criteria mentioned above might vary depending on the policy of the higher education institution in which a candidate is applying.



# RECRUITMENT SCAMS ABOUND

#### **MODUS OPERANDI**

- Racketeers collate data and details of jobseekers from sites and through a network that spans the states.
- Some racketeers send out emails and even put out advertisements in neighborhood papers.
- Their primary target is students who have not got jobs through campus placements, and mostly those from tier 2 and tier 3 towns.
- Their usual targets are students with poor communication skills.
- The racketeers use multiple SIM cards, fake letterheads and visiting cards, and once the monies come into their account, they abscond or switch off their phones.

#### **WHAT CAN BE DONE**

- Every time you get a call regarding a job opening, call the company and find out if it is hiring or go to the careers page on the firm's website and verify if the information is true.
- If the job provider conducts only a phone interview beware-most employers prefer a face-to-face interaction.
- Once you get the offer letter, always call up the company and confirm.
- Read the offer letter well-if you find errors, then it may not be genuine.
